Our childcare center serves our residents and the surrounding communities. This opening is located in Renton, WA.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develops and implements a developmentally appropriate and culturally sensitive Early Childhood curriculum in coordination with other staff.
- Develops daily individual and group lesson plans.
- Assesses the development and needs of individual children on a regular basis and makes recommendations on any referrals to the Director.
- Assists in organizing and maintaining child care room, supplies, and equipment.
- Coordinates with the child care program director in assigning program and household tasks in an equitable manner.
- Maintains verbal and written communication with parents daily.
- Interprets CV policy to assistants and parents.
- Performs necessary routines and implements schedules in cooperation with other staff members.
- Maintains health and safety standards according to licensing requirements.
- Keeps abreast of current research and practices in Early Childhood Education and the needs of homeless children.
- Develops positive relationships with the children.
- Maintains necessary records.
- Provides input to the Child Care Director on the evaluation of staff.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A.A. in Early Childhood Education or related field, or current C.D.A.
- Minimum 1-year work experience in child care, experience with beginners preferred.
- Proof of physical exam and negative TB test must be on file.
- First Aid/CPR card within 90 days.
- Food Handler’s Permit within 90 days.
- Proof of HIV/Blood Borne Pathogen training within 90 days.
- Proven ability in all areas of Early Childhood curriculum development and implementation including language development, music, art, pre-reading, pre-math, pre-science, etc.
- Ability to perform physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials
