Children's Village is a part of Vision House which is a 501(c)(3) non-profit Christian transitional housing program for homeless men, women and children. Our child care center serves our residents and the surrounding communities.

RATE, HOURS, BENEFITS:

- Hiring Bonus of \$250. Must be employed continuously for a minimum of 6 months.

- Part-Time, 25 hours per week, 12:30pm – 6:00pm Monday – Friday. Possibility for full-time hours with sustained commitment and growth.

DEFINITION: The Assistant Teacher works cooperatively with center staff in implementing a planned curriculum, providing a nurturing environment and sound classroom management according to Children's Village policy for the children enrolled in the program. The right person for this position will be flexible, able to migrate between classrooms to facilitate staff breaks and as needed to support the center.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develops positive relationships with the children, parents and other staff
- Communicates any problems or concerns regarding the program or children to the Lead Teacher
- Maintains room, supplies and equipment in coordination with Lead Teacher
- Participates in in-service training and remains knowledgeable about current research and practices in Early Childhood Education
- Implements curriculum for children under the supervision of the Lead Teacher
- Implements lesson plans for individuals and assigned groups
- Assesses group and individual needs and develops goals and objectives in coordination with the Lead Teacher
- Participates in center staff and team-building activities
- Demonstrates flexibility and patience in working with participants ages 2 months-5 years.
- Performs other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1-year child care experience preferred
- Ability to obtain initial ECE certificate within 5 years of hire as required by Washington State Department of Children, Youth & Families.
- Proof of physical exam and a negative TB test must be on file
- First Aid/CPR card within 90 days
- Food Handler's Permit within 90 days
- HIV/Bloodborne Pathogen training within 90 days
- Proven ability to learn and facilitate in all areas of early childhood curriculum development and implementation including language development, music, art, pre-reading, pre-math, pre-science, etc.
- Ability to perform physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials.
- Ability to lift 40 lbs.
- Ability to sign Statement of Faith
