ACCEPTED

We gladly accept the following items in like new condition or gently used.

- ✓ Clothing, shoes and boots (men's, women's, and children's)
- ✓ Jewelry
- ✓ Hats, purses, gloves and scarves
- ✓ Books (cookbooks, children's, paperback novels & hardback novels) and DVDs
- ✓ Games and toys
- ✓ Housewares (dish sets, un-fogged glassware, pots and pans, baking dishes, cookie sheets, kitchen utensils, and small appliances ie: coffee pots, toasters, blenders, can openers, coffee grinders and hand mixers in good working condition)
- ✓ Collectibles, knickknacks, home décor, artwork, and other giftware items
- ✓ Domestic linens (linens, blankets, towels, sheet sets and placemats with no stains, tears or rips)
- ✓ Electronics (stereos, radios, DVD players, etc.)
- ✓ Furniture (dressers [chest types], newer twin and full mattresses less than 3 years old, tables, loveseats, dining tables with matching chairs)
Note: we cannot accept furniture with stains, scratches, tears, claw marks, or smoke damage
- ✓ Personal Care Items (new unopened shampoo, conditioner, hand soap, body lotion, tooth brushes, and tooth paste)
- ✓ Household Essentials (new unopened laundry soap, dish soap, dishwasher soap or pods, toilet paper, paper towels, and food storage bags)

It is hard to refuse items that donors give from a generous heart. However, we have limited warehouse space and our first priority is to accommodate our residential units with furnishings and household items for families. The following items we are unable to accept or use.

NOT ACCEPTED

- ✓ TVs of any kind
- ✓ Cribs, car seats, baby baths, swings, and high chairs
- ✓ Household Chemical Products (pesticides, paint, paint thinner, drain cleaner, oven cleaner, aerosols and other environmentally-unfriendly waste products)
- ✓ Automotive Hazardous Waste (tires, lead acid batteries, additives, gasoline, oils, antifreeze, etc.)
- ✓ Large Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, stoves/ovens, washers/dryers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, furnaces, microwaves, trash compactors, water heaters, large console stereos, Freon based appliances, etc.)
- ✓ Medical Supplies
- ✓ Used Personal Care Items (opened or used such as shampoo, conditioner, nail polish remover, shaving cream, hairsprays, lotions and body wash)
- ✓ Older Mattresses and Waterbeds (exceptions listed in our accepted donation list)
- ✓ Carper or Carpet Padding
- ✓ Plumbing Fixtures, Building Materials, and Ceiling Lights
- ✓ Recyclables (we are not large enough for the extra space needed)
- ✓ Weapons (any kind)
- ✓ Exercise Equipment and Ski Equipment
- ✓ Computers, Monitors, Scanners, Ink Cartridges and Fax Machines
- ✓ No Encyclopedias, Text Books, Magazines, Readers Digest, National Geographic, and Computer Books
- ✓ Armoires, China Cabinets, Buffets or Hide a Beds
- ✓ No Expired Food Items (any kind)
