ACCEPTED

We gladly accept the following items in like-new condition or gently used. If you have any questions, please call 425-757-0848

- ✓ Clothing, shoes and boots (men's, women's, and children's)
- ✓ Jewelry
- ✓ Hats, purses, gloves and scarves
- ✓ Books (cookbooks, children's, paperback novels & hardback novels) and DVDs
- ✓ Games (all pieces included) and toys in good condition
- ✓ Houseware (dish sets, un-fogged glassware, pots and pans, baking dishes, cookie sheets, kitchen utensils, and small appliances ie: coffee pots, toasters, blenders, can openers, coffee grinders and hand mixers in good working condition)
- ✓ Collectibles, knickknacks, home décor, artwork, and other giftware items
- ✓ Linens, blankets, towels, sheet sets and placemats (No stains, tears, rips or stretched out elastic)
- ✓ Electronics (newer small stereos, DVD and Blu-ray players)
- ✓ Furniture: **We ask that you call first before bringing any furniture to ensure we have the space available.** Dressers [chest types only], twin and full mattresses in like-new condition (no box springs or bed frames) - must be less than 2 years old, smaller coffee tables and end tables (no glass), loveseats, dining tables with matching chairs **Note:** we cannot accept furniture with stains, scratches, tears, claw marks, or smoke damage
- ✓ Personal Care Items (new unopened shampoo, conditioner, hand soap, body lotion, toothbrushes and toothpaste)
- ✓ Household Essentials (new unopened laundry soap, dish soap, dishwasher soap or pods, toilet paper, paper towels, and food storage bags)

Donation Guidelines

It is hard to refuse items that donors give from a generous heart. However, we have limited warehouse space and our first priority is to accommodate our residential units with furnishings and household items for families. The following items we are unable to accept or use.

NOT ACCEPTED

- ✗ TVs of any kind
- ✗ Cribs, car seats, baby baths, swings, and high chairs
- ✗ Household Chemical Products (pesticides, paint, paint thinner, drain cleaner, oven cleaner, aerosols and other environmentally-unfriendly waste products)
- ✗ Automotive Hazardous Waste (tires, lead acid batteries, additives, gasoline, oils, antifreeze, etc.)
- ✗ Large Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, stoves/ovens, washers/dryers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, furnaces, microwaves, trash compactors, water heaters, large console stereos, Freon based appliances, etc.)
- ✗ Medical supplies of any kind, no shower chairs, toilet risers, walkers or wheel chairs
- ✗ Used Personal Care Items (open or used shampoo, conditioner, nail polish remover, shaving cream, hairsprays, make-up, lotions or body wash)
- ✗ Box springs, old mattresses, waterbeds, bed frames or blow up mattresses (exceptions listed in our accepted donation list)
- ✗ Carpet or carpet padding, throw rugs with stains, bad backing or animal hair
- ✗ Plumbing fixtures, building materials, and ceiling lights/fans
- ✗ Recyclables (we are not large enough for the extra space needed)
- ✗ Weapons (any kind)
- ✗ Exercise equipment, no ski equipment (boots, skies and poles)
- ✗ Computers, monitors, scanners, ink cartridges and fax machines
- ✗ No Encyclopedias, textbooks, magazines, Readers Digest, National Geographic, computer books, VHS tapes or cassettes
- ✗ Armoires, China Cabinets, Buffets, Full size couches, large desks, Hide a Beds, headboards, Recliners, TV or microwave stands
- ✗ No expired food (any kind)
